

THE PATIENT HAS TO ARRANGE FOR SUITABLE DONORS.

We recommend that you arrange donors with the following criterion:

1. The donor has to be a relative.
2. Blood group should be compatible to the patient (either the same blood type as your patient, or blood type "O." Rh factor—positive or negative— does not affect the suitability to donate, Patients with blood group AB can receive organ from any blood group)

If the Donor's Blood Group is	Donor can donate to Patient with Blood Group
O	O, A, B or AB
A	A or AB
B	B or AB
AB	AB

3. Age 18 to 45 years
4. Non-obese with built (Height and weight) almost similar to that of patient.
5. Please check the blood group of the patient and the donor
6. Kindly get these tests done for donor and send us the report
 - ✓ CBC, LFT, KFT
 - ✓ HBs Ag, Anti HCV, HIV
 - ✓ Blood Sugar
 - ✓ USG abdomen for fatty liver, Chest X ray
 - ✓ Blood group (Donor & Patient)
7. Height, weight and blood groups of the patient & donor should also be informed along with these reports.
